Subject: Nuclear fuel supplies

Following Brexit, the UK will be withdrawing from the European Atomic Energy Community (Euratom), and the Commission's Euratom Supply Agency (ESA) will no longer be a supplier of nuclear fuel to the UK. However, the international nature of the nuclear industry will require that relationships be maintained due to extant commercial contracts.

Does the Commission envisage the UK and Euratom building a 'third-party relationship'?

If not, does it expect international companies such as Urenco to maintain their current practices of having part UK, Dutch and German ownership?
