Subject: Safety of the Boeing 737 MAX

Two Boeing 737 MAX aircraft have crashed in similar circumstances in the space of six months.

Given that many EU citizens are likely to fly on this aircraft:

- (1) What steps have the Commission and, in particular, the European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) taken to guarantee the safety of European passengers while the investigations are still under way?
- (2) Despite the fact that a number of the people killed in the Ethiopian Airlines crash were EU citizens, the director of EASA has said that his agency had not been involved in the investigation. How will the Commission ensure that its aviation safety agency can be closely involved in the investigation?
