Subject: Moroccan Government actions affecting EU citizens

It is not only Sahrawi citizens who are affected by Moroccan Government actions that run contrary to fundamental rights; EU citizens also suffer. One such case is that of Claude Mangin-Asfari, a French woman married to Naâma Asfari, a Sahrawi lawyer. Mr Asfari is currently being held in prison and the Moroccan Government has on several occasions stopped his wife from visiting him.

- 1) Will the Commission Vice-President / High Representative denounce these irregularities by Morocco?
- 2) Given that the Moroccan Government is not just attacking the Sahrawi population now, but also EU citizens, will the Commission be continuing to trade and maintain other relations with a country that is opposed to cooperating with our citizens?
