Subject: Reducing CO2 emissions in the transport sector

Reducing CO2 emissions in the transport sector is the biggest climate challenge facing the EU. CO2 emissions generated by the transport sector have grown since 1990. Unfortunately, it is unlikely that CO2 emissions will decrease over the period of the 7th Environment Action Programme (2014-2020).
