Subject: State of implementation of the Joint Way Forward on migration issues between Afghanistan and the EU: return figures 2018-2019

Mr Avramopoulos's answer of 13 February 2018 to question E-007189/2017, which he gave on behalf of the Commission, contained updated figures on the current state of implementation of the Joint Way Forward on migration issues between Afghanistan and the EU. Those figures cover charter flights and repatriation of third-country nationals until 21 December 2017, their cost and coordination.

1. In the light of the foregoing, can the Commission provide information on the current state of implementation of the Joint Way Forward, in particular as regards the following:
 - (a) How many people were repatriated in 2018, what sex were they and what was their exact age?
 - (b) How many charter flights were there in 2018, from which Member States and airports, and who coordinated them?
2. Can the Commission provide an exact breakdown of the total costs borne by the Member States and/or the European Union in carrying out the 2018 flights, and specify the funds from which that money came?
