Subject: Regulatory treatment of karst pastures

Currently, karst pastures registered in the ARKOD system in Croatia account for only 72 440 hectares, which is only 6.23% of the ARKOD total of 1 116 000 hectares in Croatia.

What is the Commission's position on the separate regulatory treatment of karst pastures and, consequently, the eventual addition of additional karst pastures to the ARKOD system?

Does the Commission have information on how the karst pastures are regulated in other Member States and on the amount of support that farmers receive by surface area?
