Subject: E-evidence

On 17 April 2018, the Commission presented new rules in the form of a Regulation and a Directive to make it easier and faster for law enforcement and judicial authorities to obtain the electronic evidence they need to investigate and prosecute criminals and terrorists (proposals on e-evidence).

If these proposals are adopted as proposed by the Commission, could a German telecommunications company whose services are used by an abortion clinic in Germany be required to hand over the clinic's phone logs to Polish law enforcement authorities if the latter request them?
