Subject: No use of Italian in BTSF courses

The Better Training for Safer Food (BTSF) training course is an initiative of the European Commission, DG for Health and Food Safety (DG SANTE), concerned with animal health and welfare, food and feed safety and the health of plants used for nutritional purposes.

It is intended for operators of the competent authorities of the Member States of the European Union involved in official monitoring, in order to ensure constant updating about all aspects of European legislation concerning the relevant subjects and also to make it possible to interpret and apply it uniformly throughout the territory of the European Union.
