Subject: TFTP data retention

During discussions on the EU-US Terrorist Finance Tracking Programme (TFTP) Agreement at a meeting of Parliament's Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs (LIBE) on 12 September 2019, the Director for Security at the Commission's Directorate-General for Migration and Home Affairs declared that there is 'bulk data transfer from the service provider to the United States'. According to the Commission's joint review report¹ on the implementation of the TFTP Agreement, the US Treasury had concluded every year that it needed to retain all non-extracted data, unless it was older than 5 years and had to be deleted pursuant to the agreement.

Can the Commission confirm that the combination of these actions constitute general and indiscriminate data retention?
