Subject: Review of the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 10)

In 2015, the international community adopted the 2030 Agenda and its 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). At the core of this stands the commitment to reduce inequalities within and between countries. The European Union and its Member States were a driving force in the process leading to the adoption of the 2030 Agenda and the SDGs and both the EU and the Member States are signatories.

SDG 10 – to reduce inequalities within and between countries – is currently being reviewed in a UN-led process.

Is the Commission planning to initiate a review on the state of play of inequalities in the EU and the implementation of this SDG?
