Subject: EIGE and its resourcing in terms of violence against women

According to a presentation by Edit Bauer, a representative of the Experts' Forum of the European Institute for Gender Equality (EIGE), figures on violence against women are available in the CULT Committee only up to 2012.

- 1. In the Commission's view, why are there no data from 2012 onwards?
- 2. Can the Commission explain why there is a higher instance of violence against women in Sweden than in countries in the Balkans, particularly since Sweden is regarded as one of the frontrunners in gender equality?
- 3. What action is the Commission currently taking to support the Member States in the needsbased fight against violence against women with regard to the problem areas mentioned in question 2 in order to counter country- or region-specific violence against women?
