**Subject:** Resettlement programme and women's quota

Very recently, as part of a resettlement programme, 154 migrants travelled to Kassel (Germany) from Addis Abeba (Ethiopia).

What resettlement programmes is the Commission aware of? For each programme, please provide a breakdown as to the number of persons to be resettled and how they are being apportioned among the Member States, and say whether EU funds are being used to support those programmes and, if they are, how much funding is involved.

To what extent is the Commission aware of how many people have so far entered the EU under resettlement programmes or are to be resettled in the EU over the new parliamentary term? For each programme, please provide a breakdown as to the number of persons resettled or to be resettled, how they are being apportioned among the Member States, and gender and age.

As it is mainly young male migrants who have illegally entered the EU overland (via the Balkan route), could the Commission also support an arrangement to bring about gender balance under resettlement programmes by resettling chiefly women?
