**Subject:** EU funds for SCI Laghi La Vota – Gizzeria

Site of Community interest (SCI) IT9330087 Laghi La Vota is a retrodunal wetland area which extends along the Tyrrhenian coastline from Capo Suvero to Gizzeria Lido. The site is the sole example of a natural coastal lake to be found along Calabria's Tyrrhenian Sea coastline, with its mixed vegetation on sandy beaches and the humid conditions typical of retrodunal areas.

Projects to preserve and develop aquatic flora and fauna in this site of Community interest were earmarked for EU funding in the previous programming period (OP EFF 2007-2013).

Subsequently a further two million euro was allocated through the Integrated Local Development Project (ILDP) of the ERDF Regional Operating Plan for Calabria 2007-2013, to create paths in the park area and for rewilding in the areas bordering the lakes.

However, notwithstanding the planned funding, between the waste materials dumped there and works that have never even begun, the Laghi La Vota di Gizzeria SCI is today in a very poor condition.

In light of this, can the Commission say:

Have the measures that were to be funded under OP EFF 2007 2013 been implemented and if so, how?

Will the projects for which approximately two million euro in funding was planned first under ROP Calabria 2007 2013, and then ROP Calabria 2014-2020, be carried out?
