Subject: Citizens' feeling of insecurity about their personal data

According to the findings of a survey conducted by the IMR/University of Nicosia, a majority of 56% of citizens do not feel that their personal data are securely protected.

At the same time, a total of 47% of citizens report that they are worried about their data protection on the internet, while a majority of 53% responded that they are not much - or not at all - worried.

Respondents' responses regarding the personal data protection laws are also revealing. A comfortable majority, 61%, say that they know little or nothing about the relevant laws.

In the light of the above, will the Commission say:

- Are there any programmes at European level that include information strategies on citizens' personal data protection?
- 2. What steps will it take to help and protect people whose personal data has been violated, in particular through the Internet?
