Subject: Importation of EU goods and services into the United Kingdom following withdrawal from the EU

According to Eurostat data, between January and November 2019, the United Kingdom imported goods and services from the Member States amounting to EUR 281.9 billion. Failure to sign a free trade agreement with the United Kingdom before 31 December 2020, or to sign an agreement that would not guarantee free access to the United Kingdom market, is likely to result in losses for EU businesses.

Does the Commission have an action plan in place to reduce the losses that EU businesses would suffer if they failed to sign a favourable trade agreement with the UK?
