Subject: Increasing number of anti-Semitic and christianophobic acts in France

The Ministry of the Interior in France published its 2019 report on anti-religious acts. The figures are quite disturbing:

687 anti-Semitic events, of which 78% were threats and 22% were acts, i.e. 151 acts;

154 anti-Muslim events, of which 59% were threats and 41% were acts, i.e. 63 acts;

1 052 anti-Christian events, of which 5% were threats and 95% were acts, i.e. 996 acts;

1. Can the European Commission explain in sociological terms why there are so many anti-Christian and anti-Semitic acts, and far fewer anti-Muslim acts?
2. Does the Commission intend to acknowledge that France and the EU as a whole are suffering from christianophobia?
