Subject: Afghanistan

The EU has stated that it welcomes the result of the September elections in Afghanistan. However, the EU is in a minority in doing so, with even UNAMA being guarded in its comments and calling for the law to be respected.

- 1. Would the Vice-President of the Commission / High Representative comment on the 102 012 votes that were cast outside the polling timeframe, and the fact that 298 polling stations did not use the biometric system of voting?
- 2. Given these voting anomalies, and opposition anger at the behaviour of the Independent Election Commission (IEC), could the Vice-President of the Commission / High Representative explain the EU's almost unilateral declaration of support?
- 3. Does the very low turnout in 2019, in comparison with 2014, indicate a lack of faith and trust in the electoral process among the Afghan people?
