Subject: Togo

In light of the Presidential elections of 22 February 2020, which once again have been called into question amid allegations of corruption and ballot-rigging, would the High Representative give an overview of the EU's strategy towards Togo?

Given the unsatisfactory outcome of the municipal elections of June 2019, when the President appointed his own municipal authority in Greater Lomé instead of the elected body, does the Vice-President of the Commission / High Representative intend to hold the current government of Togo to account?
