Subject: Assistance to Member States affected by coronavirus (Covid 19)

Currently, people in every Member State are falling sick with Covid 19. Covid 19 has already infected more than 110 000 people, and 4 000 have sadly died. It is likely that Covid 19 will continue to spread rapidly, and a significant proportion of the EU population will fall sick with the virus.
