Subject: Preparatory measures taken by the Commission in the early stages of the coronavirus

On 7 January 2020, the Chinese authorities announced that a novel virus had been identified. The virus was named SARS-CoV-2. After the first case outside China was recorded in Thailand on 13 January, the virus reached Europe as early as 26 January, with three cases in France ¹. It was thus clear by the end of January that the pandemic had also spilled over into Europe.
