Subject: Arrest of pro-democracy activists in Hong Kong

With the attention of the international community firmly focused on measures to counter the COVID-19 pandemic, the Hong Kong authorities, doubtless under pressure from Beijing, seized the opportunity on Saturday 18 April to arrest fifteen leading pro-democracy activists, including Martin Lee, who is regarded as the 'father' of the movement, and Limmy Lai, founder of *Apple Daily*, the principal pro-democracy journal.

These arrests are in breach of the international human rights agreements signed by Hong Kong, its Basic Law and the Sino-British Joint Declaration, on which the polity and freedoms of the former British colony are based.

In view of this:

- 1. What measures are being envisaged by the Vice-President of the Commission / High Representative and the European External Action Service to halt these politically motivated arrests in Hong Kong?
- 2. What measures are being or will be adopted to preserve civil and political liberties in Hong Kong as China ramps up the pressure?
