Subject: Situation in Euroregions

With the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, many Member States have decided to close their borders, suspending the implementation of Regulation (EU) 2016/399 (Schengen Borders Code), which contains no provisions for a temporary reintroduction of internal border controls for public health reasons.

Indeed, the border closures have constituted a radical departure from the economic, social and cultural realities of the Euroregions, bringing cross-border economic activity grinding to a halt and flying in the face of European Parliament Resolution 2004/2257.

As Member States are now starting to ease the restrictions:

- 1. Has the Commission considered encouraging Member States to regard cross-border communities or Euroregions as entities in their own right and accordingly seek a uniform easing of restrictions within them, irrespective of national borders?
- 2. Does the Commission intend to channel funding into the Euroregions specifically earmarked for measures to deal with the economic fallout of COVID-19 and the resulting job losses?
