Subject: President's political activities in relation to gender equality

Under Article 15 of the Treaty on European Union, the President of the Council is responsible for chairing the Council's meetings and 'driving forward its work'.

In order to do so, the President appoints their own personal office, which includes a Head of Cabinet and political support staff.
