Subject: Implementation of the resolution on fundamental rights of people of African descent

On 26 March 2019 the European Parliament adopted a resolution on fundamental rights of people of African descent. <sup>1</sup> . - 1. What progress has the Commission made with the implementation of the resolution? What measures does the Commission intend to take to address structural discrimination in the EU?

- 3. Does the Commission have an insight into the number of crimes based on race or on national or ethnic origin in the EU? If so, can the Commission share this?
