Subject: Implementation of the resolution on fundamental rights of people of African descent

On 26 March 2019 the European Parliament adopted a resolution on fundamental rights of people of African descent.¹ In that resolution the European Parliament acknowledges that the discrimination experienced by people of African descent is structural and that specific policies are needed to address it.

1. What progress has the Commission made with the implementation of the resolution? What measures does the Commission intend to take to address structural discrimination in the EU?
2. More specifically, what stage has the Commission reached with the development of an EU framework for national strategies for the social inclusion and integration of people of African descent?
3. Does the Commission have an insight into the number of crimes based on race or on national or ethnic origin in the EU? If so, can the Commission share this?
