Subject: CRII and CRII+ in the light of the protection of the rights of persons with disabilities

Following the Commission's launch of two packages of measures, the Coronavirus Response Investment Initiative (CRII) and the Coronavirus Response Investment Initiative Plus (CRII+):

1. What concrete measures is the Commission taking to protect the rights of persons with disabilities and to ensure that the funds spent are in full compliance with the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities and the EU Charter of Fundamental Rights?
2. What concrete steps is it taking to ensure that no funds are invested in the expansion of segregated settings, especially considering the high mortality rates in such places?
3. Given the flexibility of the funding, how is it ensuring that partnership principles are adhered to throughout the process and what mechanisms are in place for monitoring the use of CRII and CRII+?
