Subject: EU grants for therapy programmes to integrate violent offenders from a migrant background - Part 2

I refer to my previous written question E-002652/2020. <sup>1</sup>

In its answer, the Commission states that between 2008 and 2011 the Zentrum für Integrative Psychiatrie (Centre for Integrative Psychiatry) in Kiel received a total of EUR 47 831 in EU funding. The Centre carried out a programme offering psychological care and support on a voluntary basis to offenders from a migrant background legally residing in Germany.

1. What was the total cost of the project, a figure which will show what proportion was covered by the EU funding?
2. Has a financial audit been carried out, in order to determine the precise use to which the EU funding has been put?
3. Are similar projects being carried out, or have they been carried out, in the Member States?
