Subject: Relocation of 49 unaccompanied minors from Greece to Portugal and Finland

On 7 and 8 July, 49 unaccompanied minors were relocated from Greece to Portugal and Finland as part of a scheme organised by the Commission and the Greek Special Secretary for Unaccompanied Minors, in partnership with UN agencies and the European Asylum Support Office <sup>1</sup>.

1. How old are the 49 unaccompanied minors who were relocated?
2. Have Portugal or Finland requested the available funding for participating in the programme in connection with these 49 relocated persons, amounting to EUR 6000 per relocated person?
3. Is there any provision for family reunification within the above-mentioned countries for these 49 relocated minors?
