## Question for written answer E-005094/2020 to the Commission

Subject: Latest developments as regards certified expenditure in relation to the 2014-2020

Calabria regional operational programme (ROP)

As regards the 2014-2020 Regional Operational Programme for Calabria, in its answer to question E-002433/20 the Commission stated that projects and initiatives with eligible costs of EUR 2 082 million had so far been activated.

This is confirmed on the Calabria Region's website, <sup>1</sup> according to which the programme has made even greater progress, with 99% of it having already been implemented.

However, in respect of a total programme allocation of EUR 2 379 million, the expenditure certified as at 30 June 2020 (according to Cohesion Agency data) apparently amounts to EUR 698.2 million <sup>2</sup>.

Such funding take-up, therefore, is still far from the end-of-year target and is even further from the expenditure forecasts of EUR 1 169 million made by the Monitoring Committee at its meeting of 28 June  $2019^3$ .

That said, can the Commission answer the following questions:

- 1. What are the precise certified expenditure targets to be achieved by the end of 2020?
- 2. In its view, is the current take-up of funding commensurate with achieving the N+ 3 2020 goal?
- 3. How much do the financial corrections that have so far been applied to the 2014-2020 programming period for Calabria amount to?
