Subject: Closure of plants in the Penedès region

In the last few weeks, four plant closures have been announced in the region of Penedès, which has a population of 485 027 and an unemployment rate of over 14.5%. These are the Saint-Gobain Glass plant in Arboç, which manufactures automotive glass, with the loss of 120 jobs; the Robert Bosch plant in Castellet i la Gornal, which manufactures vehicle parts, where 300 jobs have been lost; and the Alfisa and Calsonic plants, both in Santa Margarida i els Monjos and also involved in the manufacture of vehicle parts, with the loss of 105 and 77 jobs respectively. Any direct and indirect redundancies will have a huge impact in an area where, historically, the unemployment rate has always been higher than average.

- 1. What measures will the Commission take to avoid the possible closure or relocation of these plants in Penedès?
- 2. What strategies and measures will the Commission implement to protect workers and boost employment in areas such as Penedès which are severely affected by deindustrialisation and unemployment?
