Subject: The impact of Brexit on Spaniards who have emigrated to the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland

According to the Withdrawal Agreement signed by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the European Union in October 2019, it is the responsibility and duty of Member States to provide correct, timely and up-to-date information to their citizens who have emigrated to the United Kingdom on the consequences of the country's withdrawal from the EU, with a view to clarifying any concerns that might arise from the impact of this process on their lives and rights.

1. Are any mechanisms available to the Commission to assess the extent to which this obligation is being met? How does the Commission intend to ensure that the obligation is being met?
2. What other information channels, in addition to the information channels provided by the various EU governments and their embassies and consulates, does the Commission recommend to this end?
