Subject: Refugees in the EU who are unaccompanied minors

1. How many refugees are there in the EU who are 'unaccompanied minors', and what is the breakdown by gender and by year of arrival since 2015?
2. How are 'minor' and 'unaccompanied' statuses determined, and is that determination binding on authorities in all Member States? If, for example, minor status is certified at an external border or in a Member State, can an authority of another Member State revise that age determination where there is reasonable doubt?
3. How many people who have entered the EU since 2015 as 'refugees' were born on 1 January?
