Subject: Civil war in Ethiopia

The Ethiopian Government is currently refusing humanitarian access to the Tigray region, against which it has deployed a military offensive that could lead to civil war, thereby destabilising the entire region. The UN has issued a warning that this could lead to famine for millions. In the meantime, embassies are unable to evacuate their nationals.

In view of this:

- Can the VP/HR say what pressure is being brought to bear on the Ethiopian Government to allow humanitarian aid into the conflict zone?
- 2. How many EU citizens are trapped in the Tigray area and is the EEAS coordinating efforts to evacuate them?
- 3. What initiatives is the EU taking to achieve a peaceful solution to this conflict and spare the civilian population untold suffering from war and famine?
