Subject: Non-transposition of the IORP II Directive by Ireland

In April 2019, the Commission launched infringement proceedings against 17 Member States for failure to fully transpose the IORP II Directive (activities and supervision of institutions for occupational retirement provision) into national legislation. The original deadline for transposition by Member States was 13 January 2019. Now, almost two years later, Ireland is the only state not to have fully completed the transposition of the directive, and the Irish government is unable to provide a likely date on which it will finally fulfill its obligations in regard to it.

What steps will the Commission take to ensure no further delay by Ireland in the transposition of this directive?
