Subject: Norway lobster recovery plan in the Cantabrian Sea

Galicia is the EU's main fishing region. On 16 October 2020, the Galician Parliament's fisheries and shellfish committee adopted a proposal¹ urging the Spanish Government to provide the Commission with a recovery plan for the Norway lobster in the Bay of Biscay and Iberian waters (ICES subarea 8).

The Norway lobster recovery plan would take the following matters into consideration:

Establishing annual total allowable catches which make it possible for fishing grounds to be opened and operational in sustainable conditions.

Adopting fishery management measures, such as setting a maximum limit for fishing capacity and effort as well as time-area closures.

Establishing a procedure to improve the collection of scientific data on the status of Norway lobster stocks.

- 1. Has the Commission received any proposals from the Spanish Government on the Norway lobster recovery plan?
- 2. Is the Commission intending to adopt any of the measures proposed by the Parliament of Galicia?
- 3. What is the Commission's justification for its proposal² to keep the Norway lobster fishery in ICES division 8c closed and cut total allowable catches in the Atlantic and the North Sea by 11% for 2021?
