Subject: Migrants applying to several Member States for asylum

More and more migrants are applying for asylum in a Member State even though their application has already been refused in another Member State. 2. How many migrants applied for asylum in a Member State in 2018 and 2019 even though they had been granted asylum in another Member State?
3. How many migrants made a second asylum application in the same Member State which had refused their previous application?
