Subject: New COVID-19 wave and management of refugee camps in Greece

Europe is witnessing a new COVID-19 wave and Member States are already implementing various restrictions and measures to contain its impact. In particular, Greece is in a more difficult situation than in spring, with up to 2 056 new cases registered on 31 October. This comes in addition to the situation of refugee camps on the islands just a few weeks after the fire in Moria in Lesbos, which left thousands of people without shelter and with water and food shortages, while they were transferred to a temporary camp which still hosts thousands of people today. In light of the above, I would like to ask the Commission the following questions:

1. What measures does the Commission intend to take, in coordination with the Greek Government and the other Member States, to facilitate the immediate and dignified relocation of these people and thus ensure compliance with the treaties on migration and human rights signed by the EU?
2. How will the Commission ensure the necessary health and hygiene conditions in the current camps to prevent the spread of COVID-19?
3. What changes will the new Pact on Migration and Asylum bring to the situation of these people?
