Subject: Radicalisation of Muslims in schools

Following the recent Islamist terrorist attacks in neighbouring France and Austria, there has been a debate on Islamism in schools in Germany<sup>1</sup>. The terrorist attacks have been trivialised in tweets, posts and comments — and not just by pupils — justifying them on the grounds of ‘religion’ and ‘honour’.

1. What information does the Commission have regarding the increasing radicalisation of Muslims in schools in the EU?
2. How does the Commission view the future evolution of radicalisation of Muslims in schools in the EU?
3. What measures is the Commission taking to help Member States counter any drift towards radicalisation among Muslim students?
