Subject: Implementing the LGBTIQ strategy

The European Commission's strategy 'Equality Union: strategy for equal treatment of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, non-binary, intersex and queer (LGBTIQ) people 2020-2025' warns of the need for legislative developments, more and better case-law and various policy initiatives to improve the integration and inclusion of LGBTIQ people.

In view of this:

1. How will the Commission ensure that this strategy is implemented effectively across the board by all Member States and their regions, particularly in the outermost regions and remote and island areas, where, as a result their small size and associated constraints socially, educationally and culturally, these people are more vulnerable?
2. What mechanisms does the Commission intend to develop to monitor the results of the implementation of the strategy in all Member States and regions?
