Subject: EU citizens' rights after Brexit

Many EU citizens could be excluded from the United Kingdom after Brexit. Starting from June 2021, EU citizens living in the UK will be required to prove their settled status by means of a digital code, which is generated after they have successfully applied to the EU Settlement Scheme (EUSS).

However, the application is only available in a digital format and users encounter multiple barriers. While some users fall short of the digital skills needed to complete the application, others need to translate information into languages other than English in order to clearly understand their status and complete their applications.

How does the Commission plan to support EU citizens living in the UK so that they can effectively apply to the EU Settlement Scheme?
