Subject: Turkey's unilateral actions and provocations

In the report on the EU summit of 11 December 2020, the Council highlights the 'cooperative and mutually beneficial relationship' with Turkey and points out that the 'offer of a positive EU-Turkey agenda remains on the table'. The report also states that the EU is prepared to continue providing financial assistance and to cooperate on the responsible management of migration flows towards all Member States.

1. How have relations between the EU and Turkey been cooperative and mutually beneficial in recent years?
2. Is the Council considering serious economic sanctions against the rogue state of Turkey?
3. Can the Council clarify 'responsible management of migration flows towards all Member States', specifically the number of migrants covered by the Council's plans?
