In 2018 and 2019, Bulgaria, Croatia, Denmark, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Lithuania, the Netherlands, Portugal, Spain and the United Kingdom made use of these services, as did Frontex and the European Fisheries Control Agency.

- 2. Which countries and EU agencies have requested use of EMSA's drone services in 2021 and why? Which drones are to be deployed in each operation?
- 3. Which other countries or EU agencies have expressed an interest in drone operations?
