Subject: Exhaustive data on investors that bought SURE bonds

In December 2020, the Commission published an investors presentation on SURE (the temporary Support to mitigate Unemployment Risks in an Emergency instrument)<sup>1</sup>, which includes information about the investors that participated in the issuance of SURE bonds, broken down by group and geography. However, neither the investors presentation nor the press releases include information on the total number of investors that participated, the value of their holdings, or their identity.

Could the Commission provide exhaustive data on the total number of investors, the value of their holdings, and their identity and nationality? If not, what is its reason for not disclosing this information?
