Subject: Cost of the new Frontex Headquarters in Warsaw

The European Border and Coast Guard Agency (Frontex) has acquired from the Republic of Poland a site for its new headquarters in Warsaw, which is intended to house around 2 000 staff members on a floor space of 70 000 m² at a cost of EUR 12 million, according to Frontex estimates.

- 1. Where is the site of the new Frontex headquarters located and what sale terms were negotiated with the Republic of Poland?
- 2. When does Frontex plan to issue initial calls for tenders and when is work on the building scheduled to commence?
- 3. What will be the total cost of the new building (including relocation), according to Frontex estimates, and what precautions will be taken to avoid any cost overrun?
