Subject: Green Deal:

A number of trade unionists are of the view that the Green Deal will further deepen the economic and social divide between eastern and western Member States. According to Luc Triangle, General Secretary of the IndustriAll Trade Union, almost 11 million jobs in the extractive, energy-intensive and automotive industries will be directly affected. The Green Deal could lead to a further wave of (poverty) migration from south-eastern to western Europe.¹

In view of this, has the Commission carried out a Green Deal impact assessment in respect of (further) poverty migration from south-eastern to western Europe and, if so, what were its findings?
