Subject: Request for clarification of the Commission's answer to Written Question E-006222/2020

In Written Question E-006222/2020, I asked two very specific questions. In its reply, the Commission chose to express its general position on the topic I raised instead of answering my questions. I therefore feel compelled to ask my questions again.

- 1. In her political guidelines, the President of the Commission, Ursula von der Leyen, stated that she will 'seek to build a majority to unblock the Directive on Women on Boards'. What is the Commission's timetable for this 'unblocking'?
- 2. The proposal is now nine years old, and has (in my opinion on good grounds) never had enough support among the Member States for it to become a reality. At what point can the Commission consider withdrawing the proposal?
