## Question for written answer E-001312/2021 to the Commission Rule 138 Jorge Buxadé Villalba (ECR)

## Subject: Vaccine scams

The European Anti-Fraud Office (OLAF) is investigating vaccines being fraudulently offered to national governments that have made purchases on their own account to speed up the vaccination rollout. According to Ville Itälä, Director-General of OLAF, fraudulent offers of 1 billion vaccine doses have been reported, at a value of approximately EUR 14 billion.

In light of the above:

- 1. Does the Commission know which Member States have reported the scam, and exactly what sums are involved?
- 2. Has Spain reported any fraudulent behaviour to the Commission? If so, how much has been defrauded?
