Subject: Mercosur Agreement

The entry into force of the EU-Mercosur Agreement has been described as a fatal step in the wrong direction. Concerns have been expressed that it could result in additional environmental pollution, lower product quality and an even more dependent EU.

- 1. What is the justification for causing additional environmental pollution through unnecessarily long supply chains rather than subsidising local farmers and minimising long-distance transport operations?
- 2. In view of the pandemic and the resulting economic crisis, how can we justify the possible withdrawal of benefits from EU farmers under the agreement and the reallocation thereof to third-country farmers, instead of taking action to stimulate the EU economy?
