Subject: Picture posted on Commission Instagram account

A picture has recently been posted on the Commission's Instagram account showing an African man and a mixed-race child. (In line with the eccentric approach to gender roles apparently being adopted by the Commission, there is no mother in sight.) The message accompanying the photograph reads as follows: 'Think Future. Think next-generation EU'.

1. Can the Commission say how it sees the future of white ethnic Europeans in the EU?
2. Every Western EU Member State has for decades been struggling at great cost to assimilate migrants of African (including North African) and Middle Eastern origin. European citizens of the Member States concerned are all too well aware of this problem, being confronted on a daily basis with the results of failure to assimilate. It is no secret that migrants are sending enormous remittances from frequently precarious jobs or benefits, to their countries of origin, thus contributing little to the economies of the Member States. The percentage of early school leavers and unemployed in migrant communities is particularly high. In view of this, can the Commission explain exactly how African migrants will ensure the future security and prosperity of the EU?
