## Question for written answer E-002261/2021 to the Commission Rule 138 Bettina Vollath (S&D)

Subject: Extension of border fence on the Greek side of the EU's external border with Turkey

In 2012, Greece constructed a 12.5km-long fence along the section of its border with Turkey between Orestiada in Greece and Edirne in Turkey where the river Evros does not form a natural border between the two countries. In October 2020 it announced to the media<sup>1</sup> a plan to build a 26km-long wall as an extension of the fence by April 2021.

- 1. What stage has the construction of the wall reached as of April 2021?
- 2. According to Greece, the cost of the project along the river at the border is EUR 63 million. Were EU funds used by Greece for this?
- 3. What is the Commission's assessment of the fence?
